No.	Question	Answer
1	Can you please kindly clarify what is the expected start date for this service as this info is not evident clearly indicated into the RFQ document?	Taking into account the response to Question 3, the anticipated project start date is early February 2025.
2	We seek clarification in regards to being able to participate in this tender. The tender requirements refer to consultation with OEM's as part of the required scope of works. This may create a conflict of interest, and so we would not be in a position to respond to this tender. Can you please advise?	The consultant's role in terms of the engagement/consultation task for this project is outlined in Sections 2.C and 2.D of the RFQ document. The consultant will support the preparation of material and analysis. The NTC will lead the engagement/consultation process. It is up to all interested organisations to consider whether this activity will create a conflict of interest, how it can be avoided or mitigated, and whether to respond to this tender or not.
